


Fig. Special Lecture on "Academic Integrity" on February 25, 2023

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


Fig. One-Day Seminar on "Environmental Sustainability: Towards Nurturing a Greener Future"

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


Fig. One-Day Seminar on "Environmental Sustainability: Towards Nurturing a Greener Future" on June 28, 2023

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




Fig. Inaugural session of the seminar on "Sardho Satoborsher aloke Rishi Aurobindo" on 21.09.22






Fig - One Day State Level Seminar on "Contemporary Politics in India: Trends and Challenges." On September 27, 2022

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




