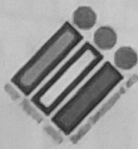

- ✓ To facilitate EVM and VVPAT familiarization and education about the robustness of EVM as well as the integrity of the electoral process using

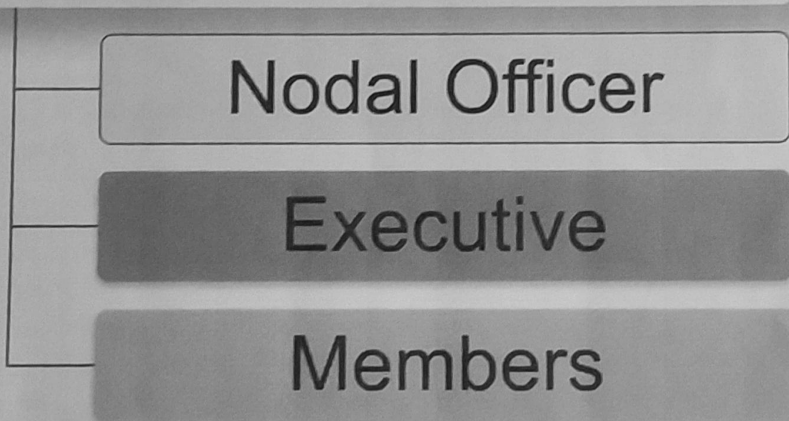

Basically, ELC works towards the generation of awareness among the students about the importance of participating in electoral procedures especially applying right to vote.



Introduction:


The Voter Awareness Camp was organized with the aim of educating the public about the importance of voting, the electoral process, and the significance of their participation in democratic governance.


Objectives:

1. **Interactive Sessions:** Engaging discussions were held to explain the electoral process, including voter registration, polling procedures, and the importance of exercising one's right to vote.


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
2. **Role Plays:** Simulated scenarios were enacted to illustrate the voting process, from registration to casting a vote, helping participants understand the step-by-step procedure.


INTRODUCTION


INTRODUCTION:



4. **Q&A Session:** Attendees had the opportunity to ask questions to the panelists and clarify their doubts regarding the electoral process and related topics.


