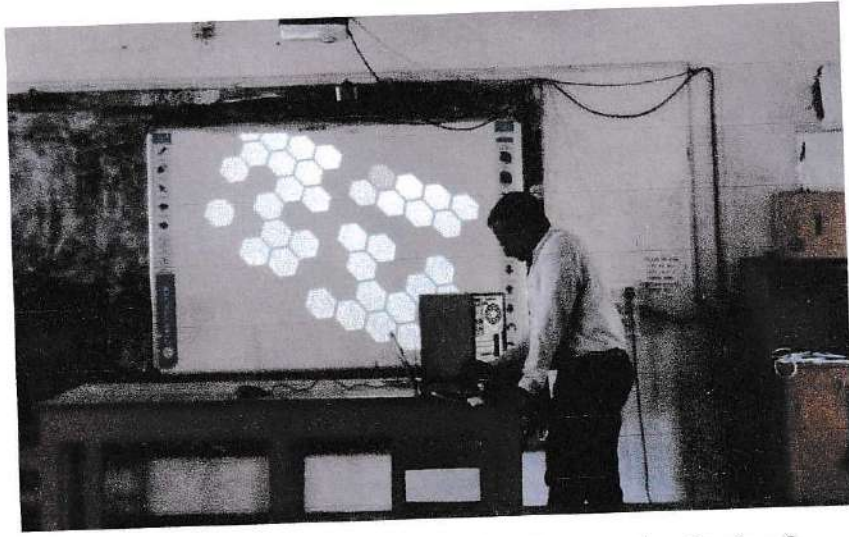

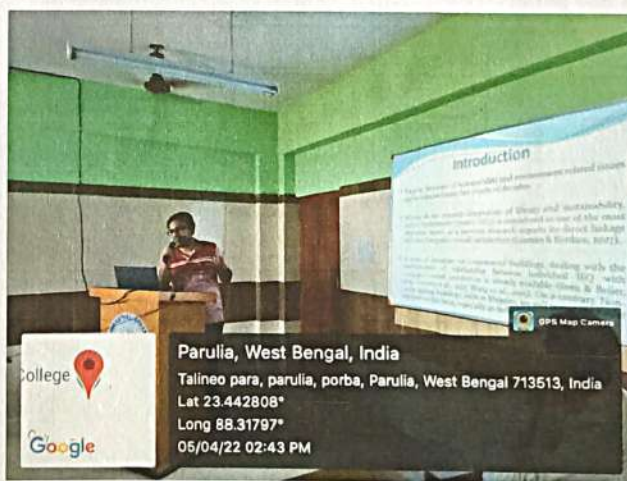


Fig. Special Lecture on “An Assessment of Indoor Environment Qualities of University Libraries” on 05.04.2022

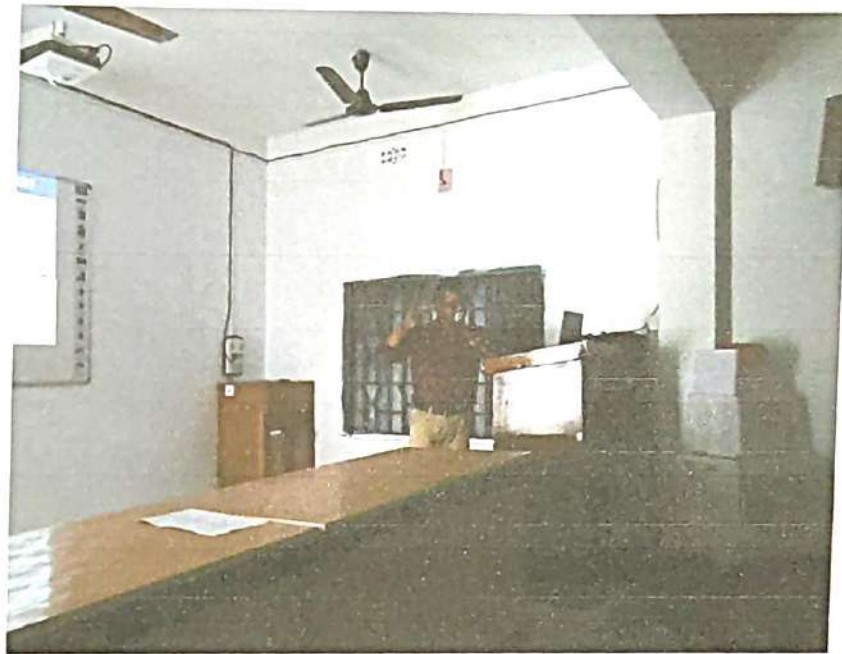
