INAUGURAL SESSION

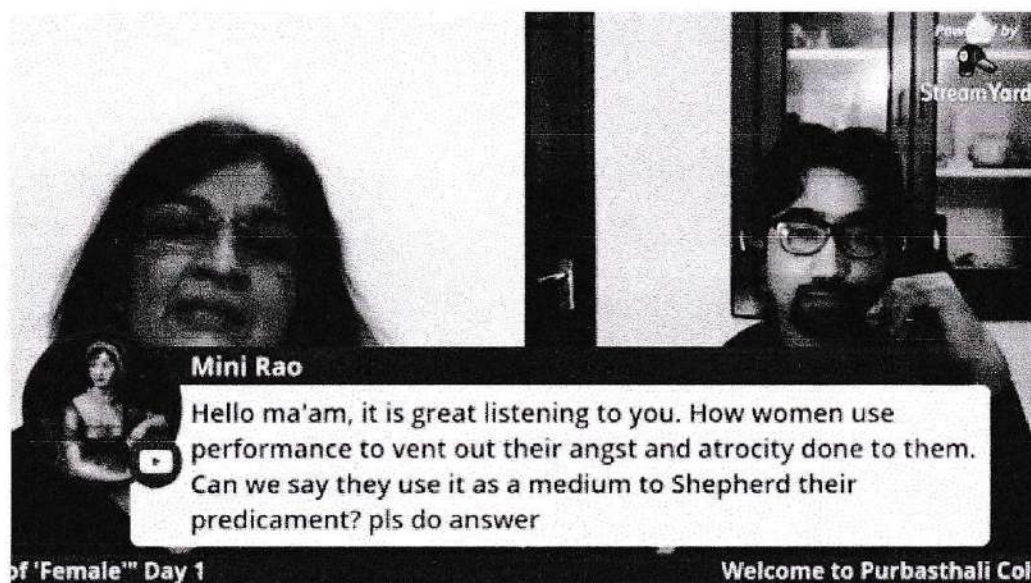
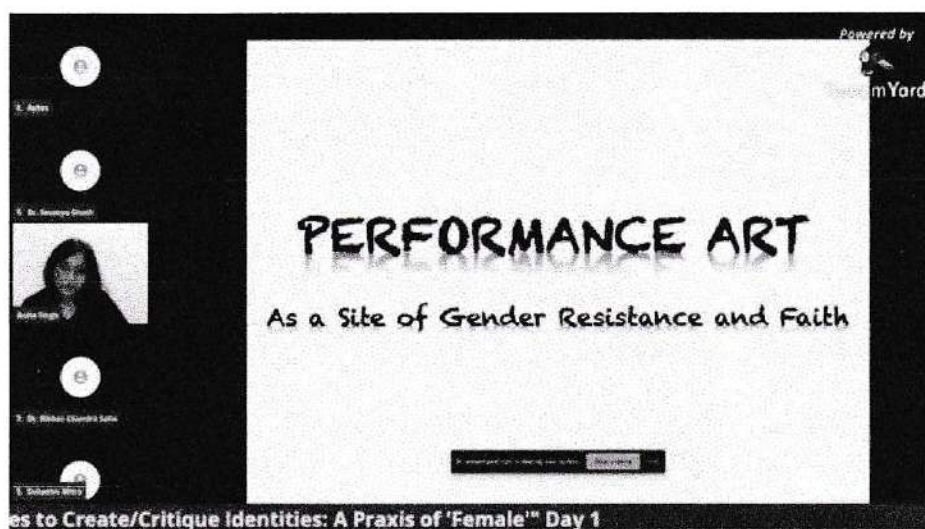


The event started with the convener cum host, Dr. Soumya Mohan Ghosh, welcoming the dignitaries on screen and introducing the theme of the e-conference. Mrs. Pratyusha Ghosh, faculty of the Department of Sanskrit, Purbasthali College, was requested to formally inaugurate the event with a song. After that the Principal cum Chairperson of the e-conference, Dr. Bibhas Chandra Saha, welcomed the guests and delivered the Chairperson's Speech. It was very recently and sometimes intermittently that these stereotypes were challenged and the boundaries meant for containing were surpassed, but it was not always received cordially. He concluded that the e-conference strived to address some of those issues in the duration of two days.


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SESSION 1- KEYNOTE ADDRESS

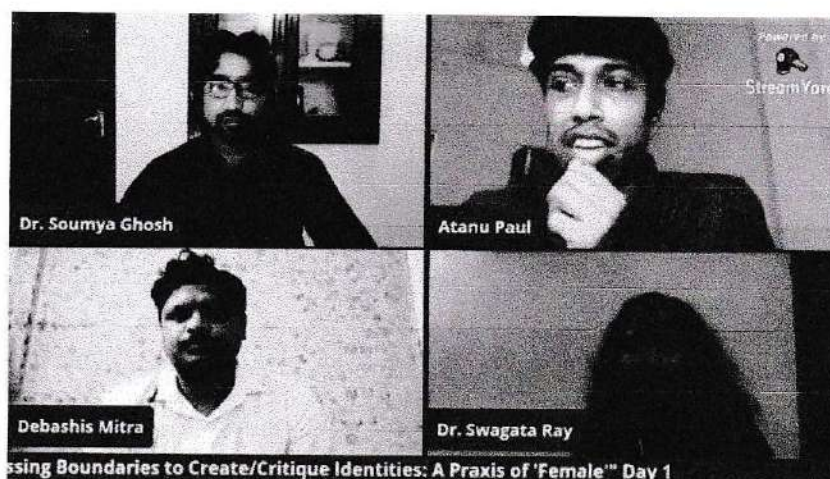

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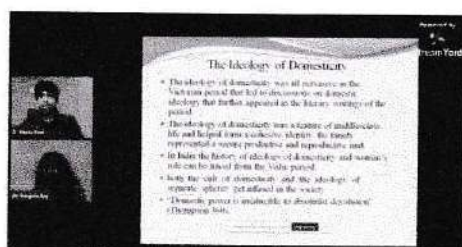

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SESSION 2- TECHNICAL SESSION I

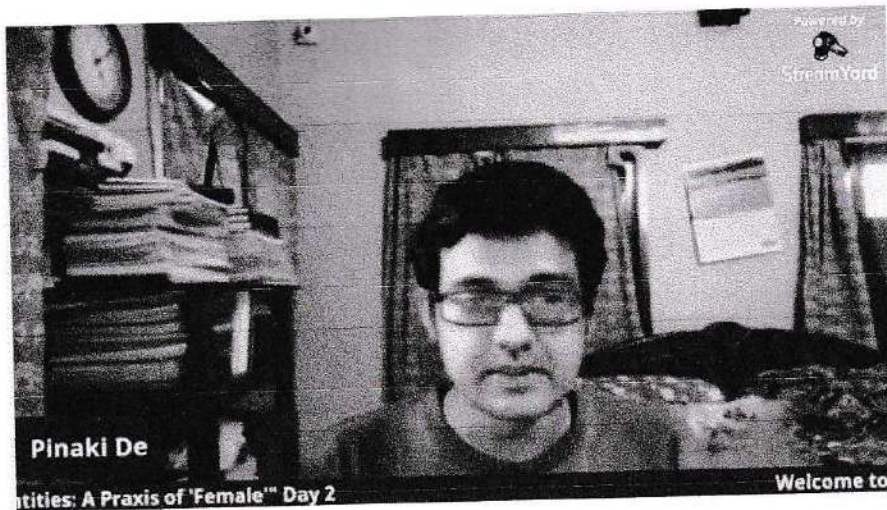

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SESSION 3- PLENARY SESSION I

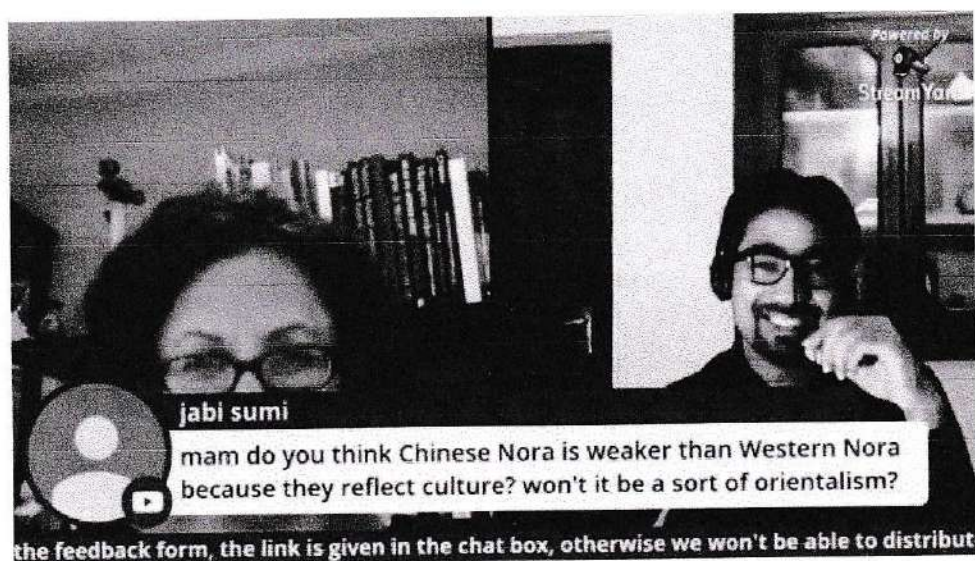
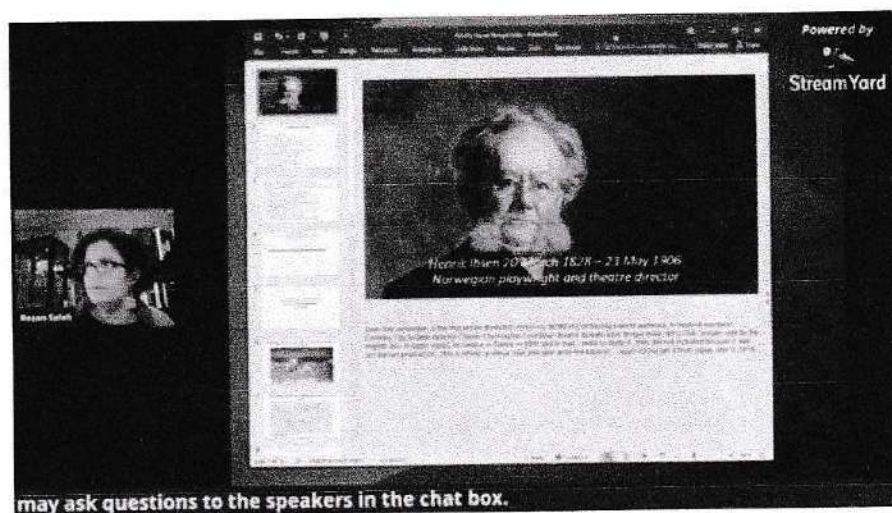

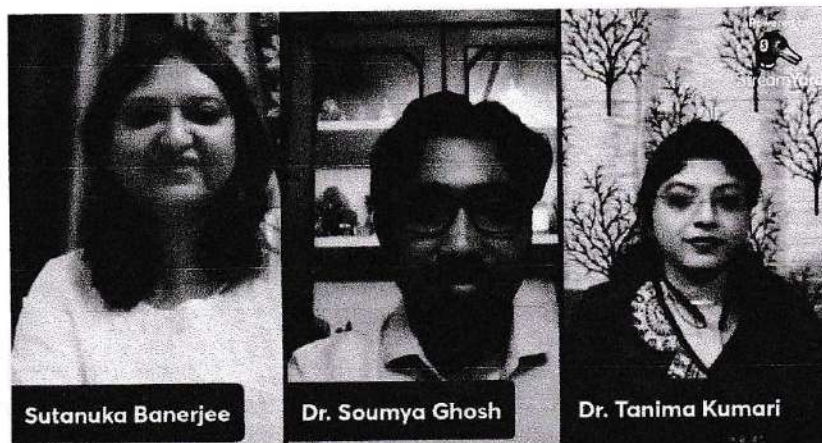
PARTICIPATION

INAUGURAL SESSION

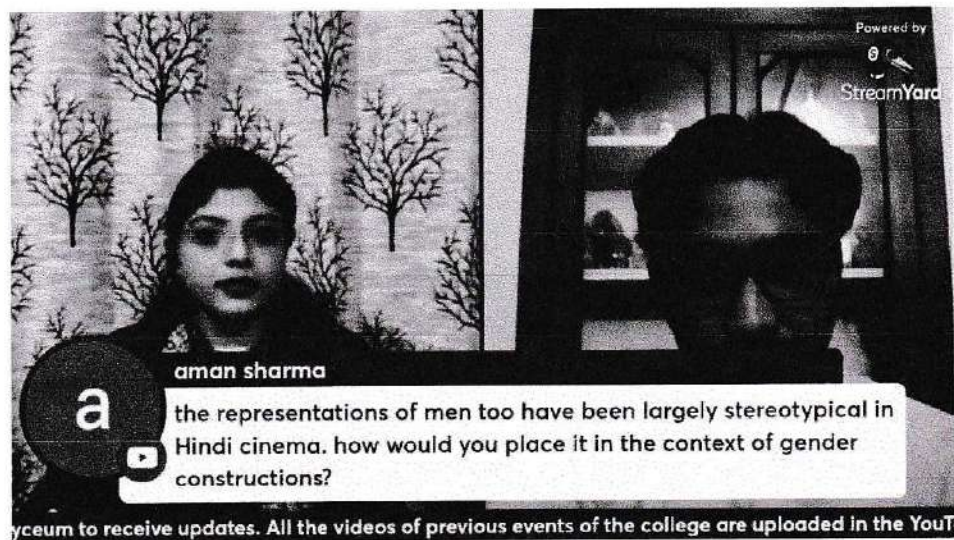
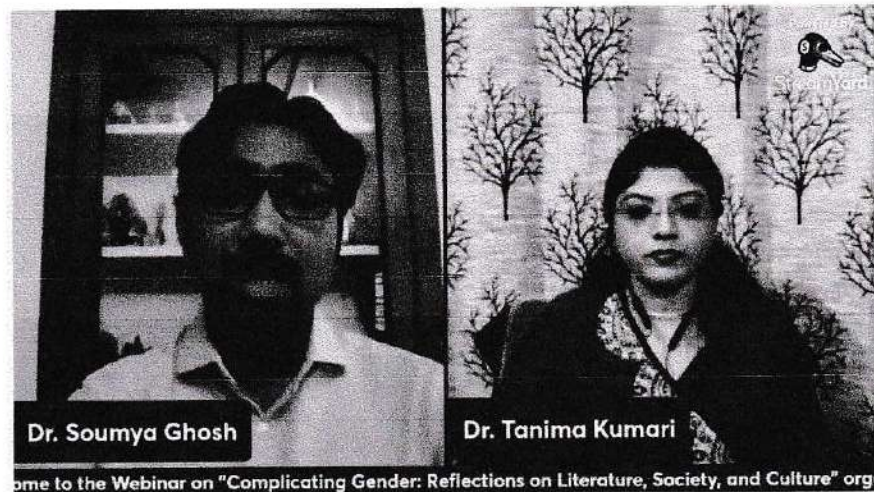
