

INTRODUCTION

The event aimed to present Sanskrit with its vast philosophical aspect which tries to focus a vision of an interconnected universe with a single, unifying principle behind the apparent diversity in the cosmos, any articulation of which is called Brahman, the unchanging core of human individual. The webinar was streamed live in the YouTube platform as to have convenience of accessibility for the viewers of all over the world.

SESSION 1



After the end of the inaugural session, the first session began in which the main speaker was Dr. Pritilaxmi Swain, Assistant Professor in the Department of Sanskrit, Pali & Prakrit, Visva-Bharati University, Santiniketan, West Bengal, India. The title of her lecture was "वाक्यपदीयस्य ब्रह्मकाण्डे शब्दब्रह्मणः स्वरूपम्". She, at first, did मङ्गलाचरणम्, prayer to the almighty. Professor Swain detailed about the subject matter and importance of the book वाक्यपदीयम् which is authored by भर्तृहरि. Bhartrihari was a great grammarian and philosopher who explored the depth and breadth of Sanskrit grammar. Her presentation revealed the real nature of the speech element शब्दतत्त्व or शब्दब्रह्म which is eternal and beyond birth or death. She also elucidated शब्दब्रह्म as the all pervaded essence of the universe.

This session ended with a brief discussion and question-answer session.
